

**FCC Amateur Radio Technician License  
 Training and FCC Exam

<b>WHERE:</b>	El Camino Hospital - Los Gatos (Pollard Rd)

<b>TIME:</b>	<b>The class starts promptly at 8:00a (please arrive 15 minutes early)</b> The FCC examiners take over at 4:00p (The exam is 35 multiple choice questions, on-line, no time limit) A notebook computer will be provided when you take the exam, or use your own.
<b>Class FEE:</b>	No charge for the class ( <b>but, the FCC examiners charge \$15 for the exam</b> ) And, the FCC charges \$35 when they grant you their Amateur Radio Technician license (renewable every 10 years without an exam). Reimbursed if under 18.
<b>WHAT TO BRING for the Class:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Lunch – Bring your own or purchase from the Cafeteria.           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be a lunch break plus morning &amp; afternoon bio breaks</li> <li>• Beverages – bring your own or purchase from the cafeteria</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>WHAT TO BRING for the Exam:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Identification: <b>One</b> <u>government-issued photo ID</u> such as a driver’s license or passport, or any <b>two</b> non-photo IDs such as birth certificate w/appropriate seal, minor’s work permit, school report card, school ID card or library card.</li> <li>· You will need an FCC Registration Number (FRN) to take the exam. Get it here <b>now</b>:  <a href="https://hamradioprep.com/how-to-register-for-your-frn/">https://hamradioprep.com/how-to-register-for-your-frn/</a></li> <li>· <b>\$15.00 Exam Fee (\$5.00 for those under 18)</b>            (Exact Cash, or Check made payable to <b>ARRL VEC</b>).</li> <li>· Calculators, scratch paper, and pencils are provided if you want them.</li> </ul>

<b>BEFORE the Class:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Take at least <b>one practice exam</b> before the class (takes about 15 minutes)  <a href="https://hamexam.org/exam/18-Technician">https://hamexam.org/exam/18-Technician</a></li> <li>· The more practice exams you take, the higher your actual score will be.            (Take <b>ONE EXAM each day ... 15 MINUTES ... NO REASON TO PREPARE</b>)</li> <li>· Taking the practice exam helps you become familiar with the exam.            You will only be able to answer 8 or so questions correctly because you haven’t taken the class yet. The class will cram the information into your head for 8 hours and then it will slowly leak out onto the answer sheet.</li> </ul>
